ORIGIN / VINTAGE / ALCOL PERCENTAGE:

Frascati, Rome, Italy / 2021 / 12,5% vol.

VARIETAL: Malvasia del Lazio and Bombino from 70 years old vines

VINEYARD: Guyot vines 70 years old on volcanic soils with prevalence of basalts, exposed to mediterranean wind. 4000 vines per hectar.

HARVEST: Early september

FERMENTATION: Spontaneous fermentation, indigenous yeast, no clarification and no filtration.

AGEING: Aged 6 months in French oak barrels

NOSE: Peach sangria with mint, balsamic and refreshing. Back to basics wine.

CHARACTER: It's unplugged. This is a wine for people who like to sleep on the floor, play rugby, climb mountains and do other things where some suffering is part of the fun.

OCCASION: To drink when you have the joy of drinking without too many superstructures.

PRODUCTION: Entirely produced and bottled by Merumalia, 600 bottles

BOTTLE: 750 mL Borgognotta with recycled plastic cap, 100% reusable, water ink label, low environmental impact

SUSTAINABILITY: Net bottle weight 600 gr, eco-friendly packaging, use of green energy (certified by Tüv Süd), energy savings in the cellar
